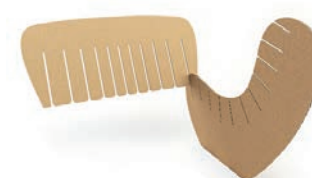
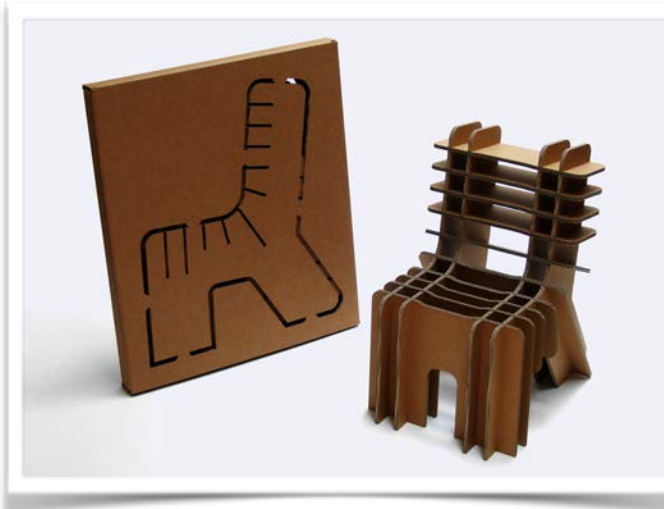


----- Dotted lines indicate where to bend cardboard. Allow ~.5cm of material for bend.

1. Assemble part 1 and part A using the outer slit of part A and the first slit of part 1.



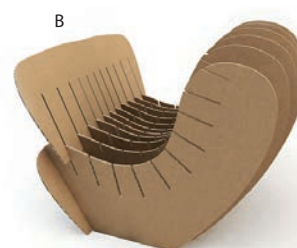
2. Turn the assembled parts 1 and A in such a way that part 1 lies on its side and part A points upward.



3. Now add part 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 working upwards by sliding them in the slits of part A.



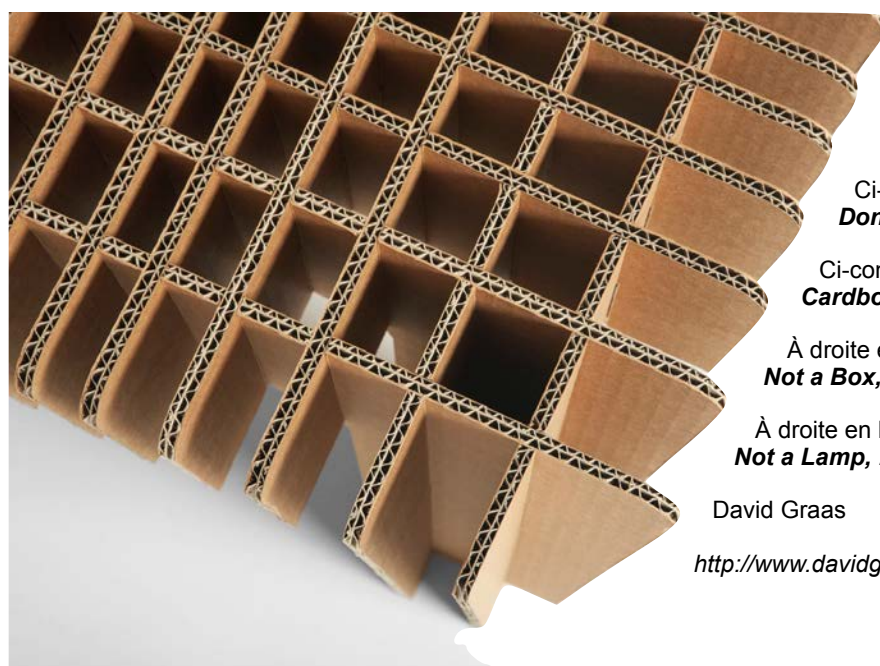
4. Turn back up and space out all parts evenly.



5. Now add part B in the second position by gently pushing it down in the slits. Make sure to keep the part horizontal all the time and in line with the slits of parts 1 to 6.



6. Continue with part C, D, E etc. until part K, working from front to back.

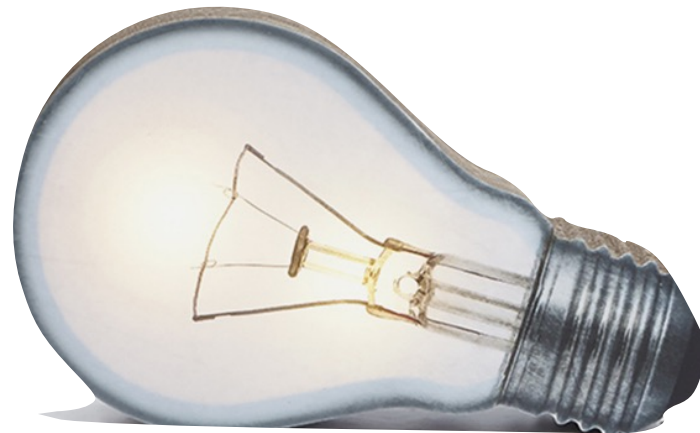

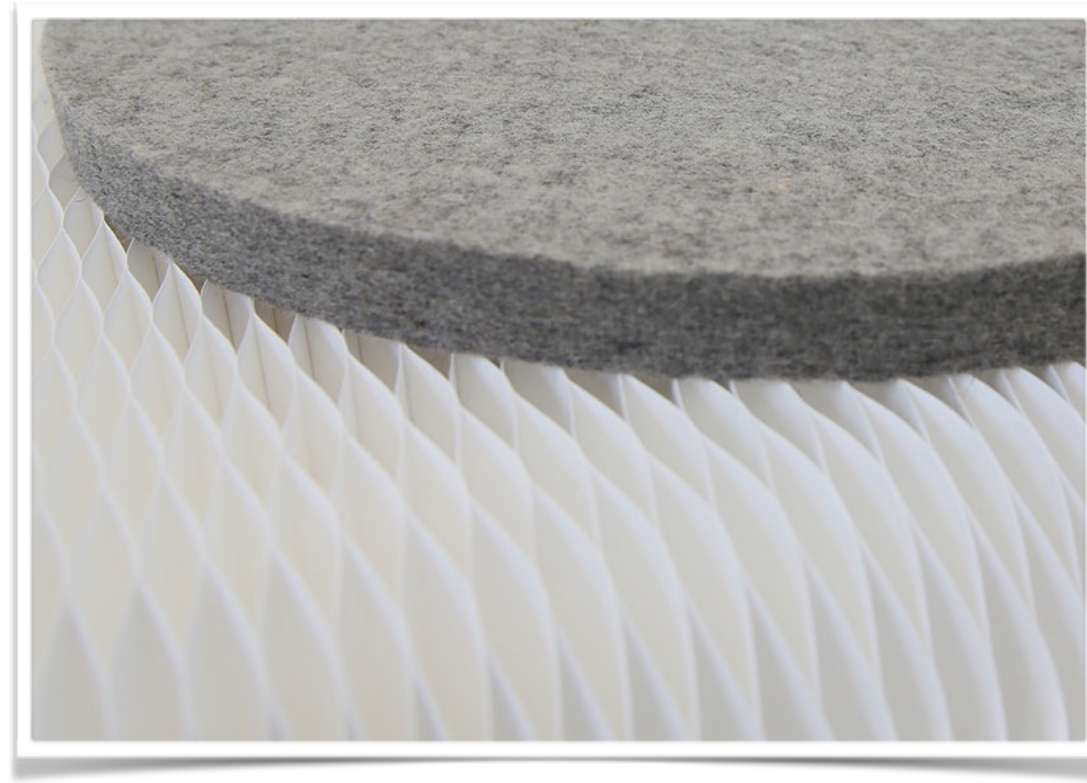
